Gwen Owens updated us on the possibility of a cross walk at Carillion and Lake Park noting that often this affords a false sense of security to pedestrians and can do more harm than good. It had been brought up at council and Gwen plans to contact that citizen.

Ralph Doak mentioned the overgrown foliage at south bound Carillion and Vauxhal, noting drivers cannot see past the foliage. Gwen Owens look at the sight distance triangle and report back.
