Vice Mayor Singleton called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

The roll call found Shelton, Lagge, McCune, Canning, Bezanson, Crews, Canning and Singleton present.

We saluted the American Flag.

The minutes of the last meeting were presented to all members in advance; no changes were recommended. Crews moved that the minutes be accepted, Shelton seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Shirts and ID's for National Night Out-This item was tabled to the next meeting by McCune.

Cleaning the sand boxes-this item has been resolved per McCune

Homeless at Dry Creek-Lt. Vizzusi updated the group on this topic advising the Police are moving these folks along. Police also working with area group homes to thwart panhandling.

Roundtable:

Roadway/off ramp area NB 99 and Simmerhorn:

Gwen will be checking with Caltrans again noting that there are known right of way issues. Lagge thanked Public Works for the prompt handling of the lines in the roadway at Lincoln and Simmerhorn.

Shelton reminded the group that fire season is not over noting there is an issue in the area of Bernal at the county line. Seems to be a lengthy process starting with Code Enforcement, the CSD and on to Chief Hansen if necessary. Vizzusi will follow up with Rusty. Lagge added weed control is needed in the area of Adare and Walnut. Vizzusi will tell Rusty.

Speeding near Walker Park continues to be an area of concern. Gwen will request the County conduct a survey. Speeding in many areas including near Greer School and South Lincoln at Singletree. Discussion followed explaining speed surveys, the Vehicle

Code laws, critical speeds and how these all affect Posted Speed Limits. The changing speed limits in the area of South Lincoln and Singletree seem troublesome and Gwen agreed to look into it.

Twin Cities Road/Roundabout Construction: McCune questioned the down time and inconvenience of the construct in the area of the new roundabouts. Gwen advised that the construction would cause some rolling closures but the detours and closures would be very limited to just a few days at any one place, causing as little inconvenience as possible. Shelton questioned the passing of the large equipment belonging to area dairies, hoping their needs were taken into consideration prior to road closures.

Crews brought up the poor lighting of the cross walks in the area of Lake Canyon and Carillion inquiring if increased lighting is possible.

Canning questioned the signage warning of a blind curve in the bike trail on one direction only. He agreed to forward details to Gwen.

Water Pump Repairs have been causing some low water pressure. Gwen believed the repair completion would be within just days.
