McCaffrey - The issue here is driver are ignoring the posted speed limit. Especially around the south end of Park Terrace.
River Oaks Elementary- This school has crossing guards to protect the children as they cross the intersections. In more than a dozen cases I have observed vehicles ignoring the crossing guards and driving through the streets as children are crossing. The second issue is vehicles passing stopped vehicles in front of the school.
Both sites of these are related to impatient drivers. I would like to request the motor unit post up in the area(s) of Summit Lakes and Vintage Oak
to monitor traffic and cite violators during the two heaviest pedestrian periods. When schools starts and as school is being let out. And on Park Terrance and Bay Vista.
