**SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Council Chambers, 380 Civic Drive, Galt, California
Friday, January 22, 2021**

This meeting of the Galt City Council was conducted by video/teleconference in compliance with the State and County Shelter at Home Orders, and as allowed by the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20, which allowed for a deviation of teleconference rules required by the Brown Act.

CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE:

1. **SUBJECT:** Proposed Placement of Sexually Violent Predator in Unincorporated Area of Galt.
RECOMMENDED ACTION: Authorize the Mayor to sign a letter on behalf of the City Council opposing the placement of a Sexual Violent Predator (SVP) from Humboldt County in Sacramento County for supervised release just outside City limits and provide further direction to staff related to the upcoming hearing on January 29, 2021 regarding the proposed SVP placement in Sacramento County.

ACTION: Upon a motion by Lozano, seconded by Sandhu, authorizing the Mayor to sign a letter on behalf of the City Council opposing the placement of a Sexual Violent Predator (SVP) from Humboldt County in Sacramento County for supervised release outside City limits and approving the City Manager, Mayor and Interim Police Chief Kalinowski to speak at the hearing on January 29, 2021, was approved by a unanimous roll call vote.
