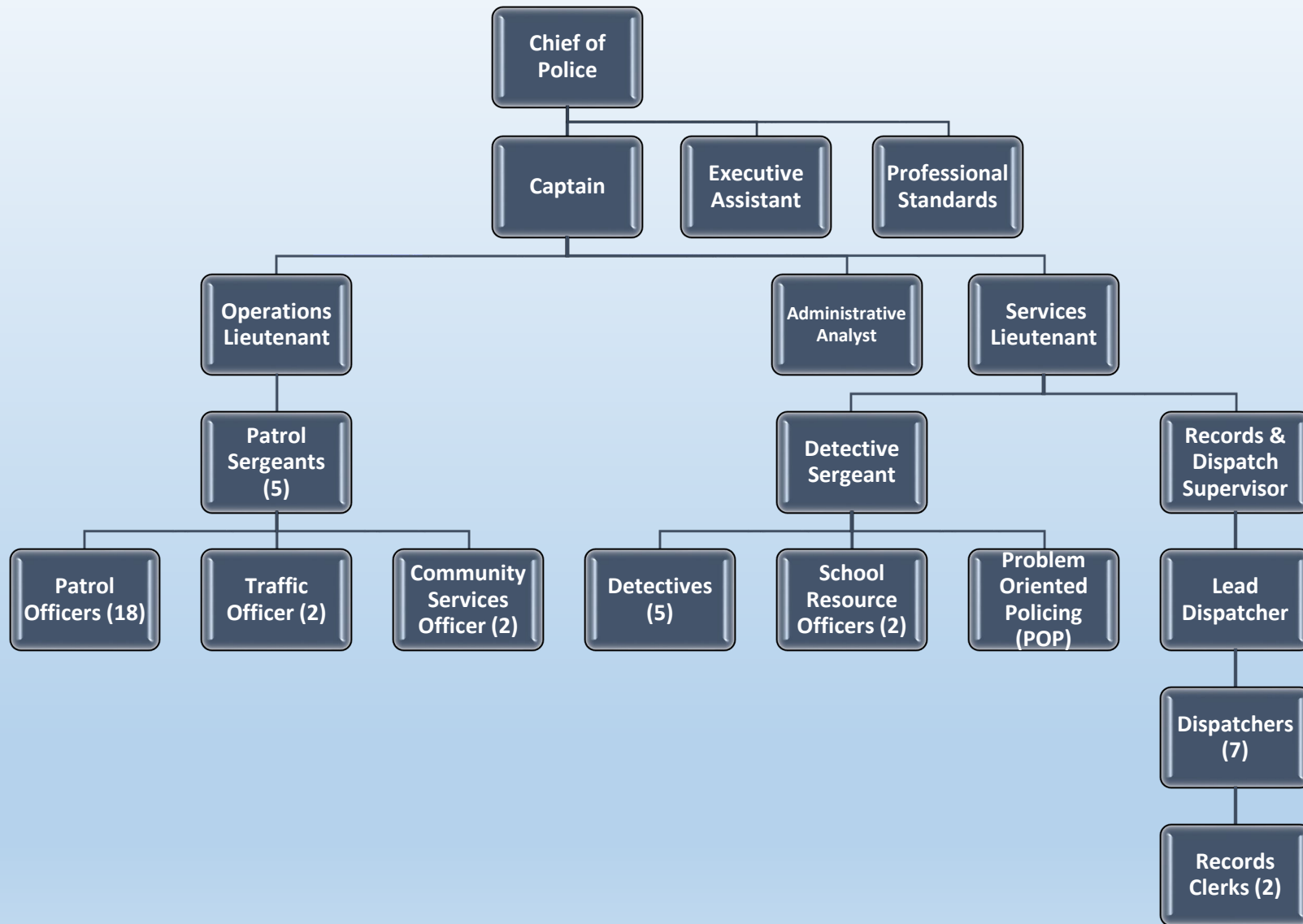

# OPERATIONS DIVISION

LT JOHN ROCHA, DIVISION COMMANDER

## Patrol

- Respond to life threatening and in progress criminal activity
- Address quality of life issues in neighborhoods
- Perform peacekeeping activities such as mediating disputes
- Problem solving resource.

## Traffic Enforcement Unit

- Primary duty is the enforcement of traffic laws in order to:
- Reduce traffic collisions
- Facilitate the safe and expedient flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.



# OPERATIONS CONT.

## Canine (K9) Unit

- Suspect apprehension
- Protection
- Article detection
- Tracking
- Search and Rescue

## Bike Patrol

- Patrol the city's shopping areas, parks, schools, and greenbelts
- Attend special events
- Police bicycles can easily access alleyways, sidewalks, parking lots, and wooded areas with dirt trails



# OPERATIONS CONT.

## Hostage Negotiation Team

- Specially trained unit of highly skilled crisis/hostage negotiators
- Resolve the crisis or hostage situation through negotiations that will result in a peaceful resolution
- Hostages rescued safely
- Law enforcement personnel uninjured and all suspects safely in custody.

## SWAT

- Trained in special weapons and tactics
- The mission is the preservation of life and property during critical incidents and high-risk operations
- Respond for service of high-risk search and arrest warrants
- Incidents involving barricaded suspects, hostage rescues, or active shooters.



# OPERATIONS CONT.

## Unmanned Aircraft Systems

- Lost or missing persons
- Search and rescue events
- Mass gatherings or special events where security concerns exist or criminal activity is occurring
- Post-incident crime scene preservation and documentation
- Public safety and life preservation missions including, barricaded suspects, hostage situations, active shooters, apprehension of armed and dangerous fleeing suspects, and high-risk search warrants

## Honor Guard

- Highly motivated
- Maintain exceptionally high standards of appearance and conduct
- Aptitude for ceremonial duty.
- Primary role of the unit is to provide funeral honors for fallen comrades.



# OPERATIONS CONT.

## Community Services Officer

- Instrumental in ensuring the availability of sworn police officers to conduct more critical patrol activities
- Take reports
- Enforce parking and other city code violations
- Arrange and coordinate the towing of vehicles
- Perform crime prevention tasks
- Direct traffic
- National Night Out

## School Resource Officer

- Responsible for safety and crime prevention in schools
- Responsibilities are similar to regular police officers
- Have the ability to make arrests, respond to calls for service, and document incidents that occur within their jurisdiction
- Serve as educators, emergency managers, and informal counselors



# SUPPORT SERVICES DIVISION

LT. BRIAN AZEVEDO, DIVISION COMMANDER

## Investigations

- Responsible for the thorough investigation of major crimes, including:
- Burglary, Child abuse, Elder abuse, Embezzlement, Forgery, Grand theft, Homicide, Identity theft, Rape, and Robbery
- Working solo or as a team, collect evidence, secure statements from the involved parties, and bring the investigation to a close.
- Detectives work very closely with the District Attorney's Office.

## Dispatch

- Primary communications center for all Galt Police Department.
- Dispatching officers to emergency and routine calls for service
- Contacting local law enforcement agencies as needed
- Contacting fire and emergency medical services as needed
- Monitoring surveillance cameras



# SUPPORT SERVICES CONT.

## Problem Oriented Policing

- An approach to tackling crime and disorder that involves:
- Identification of a specific problem
- Thorough analysis to understand the problem
- Development of a tailored response
- Assessment of the effects of the response

## Property and Evidence

- Responsible for receiving, properly storing, and maintaining the integrity of evidence, found property, and property held for safekeeping.
- The Property and Evidence Unit also releases property to it's rightful owner and facilitates the proper disposal of property.



# SUPPORT SERVICES CONT.

## Records

Processing and maintaining the integrity of all:

- Police reports
- Traffic citations
- Criminal complaints
- Court Liaison

## CAPS Volunteer Program

- Volunteer program for civilian men or women over the age of 18
- Donate their time to making their community a safer place.
- School patrol
- Vehicle abandonment
- Parking enforcement/non-moving violations
- Vacation checks
- Traffic control
- Office duty
