**F. REGULAR CALENDAR:**

- a. Minutes – July 21, 2022 Minutes. Motion made by Sandhu to approve, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lampson. Motion passed 5-0
- b. Home of the Month – Sandhu, Firestone & Webber met on Wednesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm and passed out 2 Home of the Month certificates – Sean & Ilene Givens on Buttercup and Ron & Sherri Raeta & Charles Becker on DiMaggio. Notices were left for 2 other homes. One on Emerald Dr reached out but did not set a date and we never heard back from home on Palin. 
